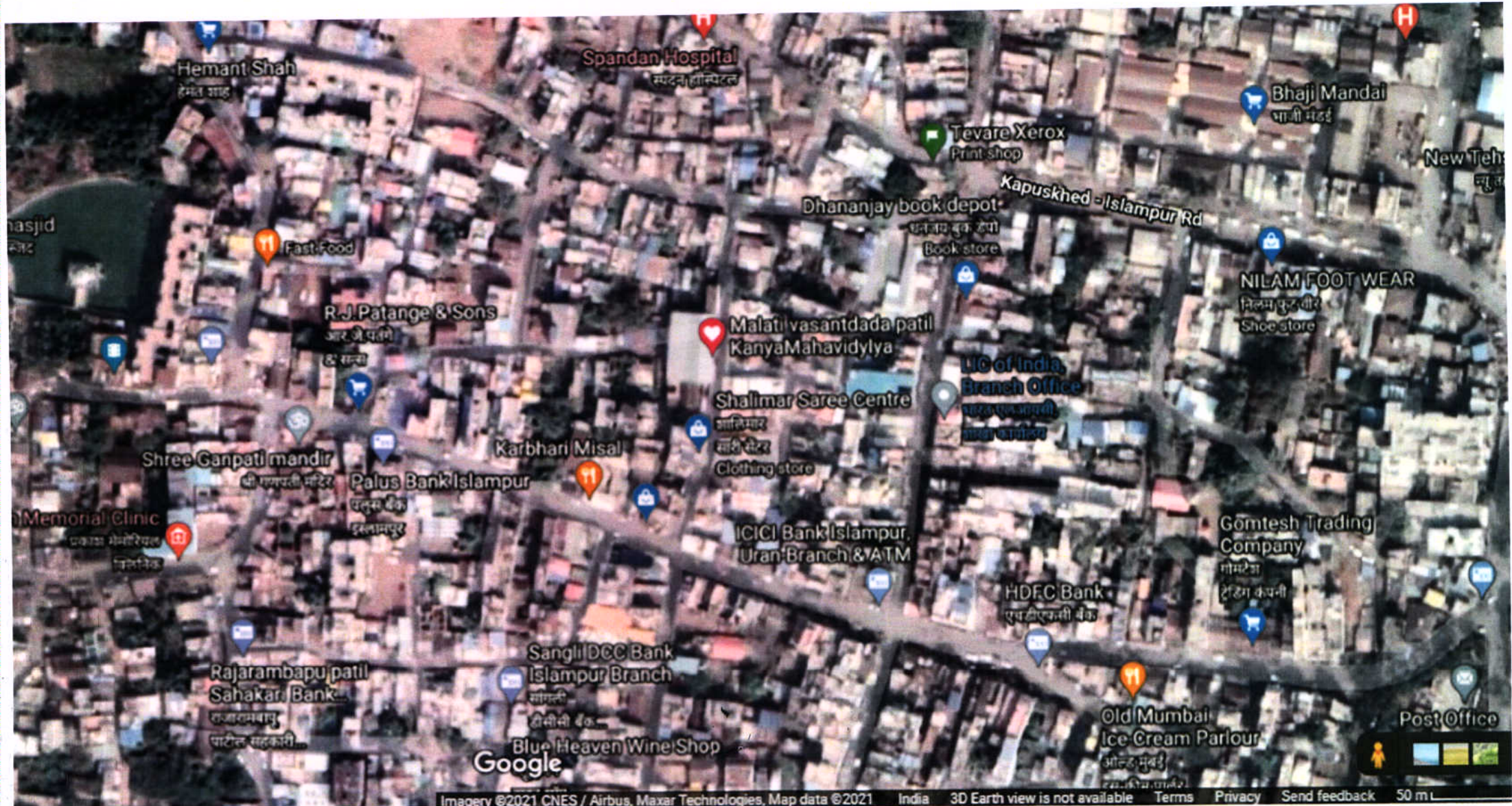





The meeting of Anti-Ragging committee held in the principal's cabin at 1.00 PM.




