

13.Physical And Academic Infrastructure

The college is located in islampur and spread over a campus of 1077.8 sq.mtr. The college is established in 1989 and has adequate facilities and infrastructure for imparting higher education. The college has 17 classrooms 3 laboratories and 7 departments e.g. English, Marathi, Hindi, History, Sociology, Accountancy and Industrial Management, administrative office, principal's cabin, staffroom, NSS office, auditorium, small seminar hall, language lab, computer lab, IQAC cell, examination cell, study room, librarian cabin, fully automated library having 19938 text books and reference books and 565 donate books, rare books, manuscripts and other facilities such as e-books, e-journals etc. There are various sections in library viz-periodicals, circulation, photocopying, and referral services which are rendered to the faculty and the students. The college has separate toilet facility for students, staff, and principal also. The college has fixed the CCTV cameras in the passage of the college campus. Filtered water facility is available in the campus. Wi-Fi facility is made available to the students and the staff.

There is a three storied ladies hostel with 42 rooms. Ground floor includes warden room, visitors room, Kitchen servant's room, and Dining hall and store room. Total accommodation capacity is 100+ seats. The college has no playground in the college campus, but it is available in the campus of parent institute.

Prohibition of Ragging and Rules of Discipline

University Grants Commission, Shivaji University Kolhapur and as per the directions of Government of Maharashtra Anti Ragging Cell has been established in the college. Maharashtra State Government has implemented 'Maharashtra Anti-Ragging Prevention Act 1999 ' in order to prevent misdeeds like ragging. Similarly, the University Grants Commission has established a ragging prevention committee in the college under the act 'UGC regulation on curbing the menace off ranking in higher education institution 2009'.

Also as per Supreme Court directives in colleges-

- 1. Mental, Physical, Sexual harassment of students in any way in prohibited.
- 2. No one should harass anyone unnecessarily in the college campus, classrooms and ladies hostel.
- 3. Do not ask a student younger than you to do your personal work.
- 4. A student should not be singled out.
- 5. Harassment and discrimination on the basis of race, caste, religion, gender, nationality, language, regionalism, transgender, body color, sarcasm etc. should not be done.
- 6. Do not exploit financially.
- 7. Do not cause physical harm.
- 8. Do not misbehave by speaking.
- 9. In case of ragging, report to Committee.
- 10. Ragging will result in suspension from the college.
- 11. In case of ragging strict legal action will be taken as per Supreme Court.

As per the provision of Maharashtra Act XXXIII, known as 'Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act of 1999' students indulging in ragging can be punished under the act resulting in either suspension, exclusion from the college and upto imprisonment with heavy fine.

The word 'Ragging' means the act causing, inducting, compelling of forcing a student. whether by way of a practical jokes or otherwise, to do any act which detract from human dignity or violets his person or exposes him to injurious him or by using criminal force to him or by holding out to him any threat of such intimidation. Wrongful confinement, injury or the use of criminal forces'

Forms of Ragging :

Ragging is found to take the following forms (the list only indicative and not exhaustive)

Crisp orders : to address senior as 'Sir/Madam' and 'Sister/Brother' (for nursing field)

To perform mass drills.

To copy class notes for the senior.

To serve various errands.

To do menial jobs for seniors.

To ask/answer vulger questions.

To look pornographic pictures to 'shock the fresher's out of their innocence.

To force to drink alcohol, scalding tea etc...

To force to acts this can lead to physical injury/mental torture or death.

To strip, kiss etc. to do other obscenities.

Punishments :

While the first 08 types of punishment can be awarded by the appropriate authority of college itself, the last punishment can be awarded only by court of law.

- 1. Cancellation of admission.
- 2. Suspension from attending classes.
- 3. Withholding /withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
- 4. Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- 5. Withholding result.
- 6. Debarring from representing the institution in any state, national and international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- 7. Expulsion from the hostel and from institution for the period varying from 6 month to a year.
- 8. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any] other institution fine up to Rs. 25000/-
- 9. Rigorous imprisonment up to 03 years.

Any incident of ragging reported to taken place outside the college campus, without any enquiry, the complaint shall be forwarded to the police.

Note : Ragging is strictly prohibited in college/ hostel/ clinical. If any student if found guilty shall be entitled to the above punishment as appropriate.

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
